Ambassador Conrad A. Bruch was born on May 25th, 1960, in Luxembourg City. After completing the Lycée classique d'Echternach in 1980, he studied political science and Slavic languages in Trier (Germany). He graduated from Trier University in 1988 (Magister Artium). In 1988-89, he studied at the Paris Institute for Political Studies, where he took the Cycle supérieur d'Etudes soviétiques et est-européennes (laureate).



Mr. Bruch joined the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Luxembourg in the early 90s. Within the Ministry, Mr. Bruch was responsible for security policy and for CFSP affairs as European Correspondent.

In October 2010 Mr. Bruch became the Luxembourg Ambassador to Poland.

Following Bartosz Jalowiecki, the Polish Ambassador to Luxembourg, Mr. Conrad Bruch is the 2nd Honorary Member of LPBC. The support and advisory role of diplomats is of great importance in tightening business relations and business activities between both countries.
