Artur Sosna: As of September 1st, you are Ambassador of Luxembourg to the Republic of Poland. This is a new country for you, which you visited for the first time only 2 months ago. Can you tell us about your first impressions?

H.E. Paul Schmit: Indeed, I just arrived here on September 1st and had the chance to be accredited during a very cordial ceremony two weeks later. This allows me to function as Ambassador and meet the Polish authorities as well as actors from the political, economic and cultural sectors. In addition we have a network of seven Honorary Consuls in Poland whom I will meet in the coming weeks, COVID-19 permitting. 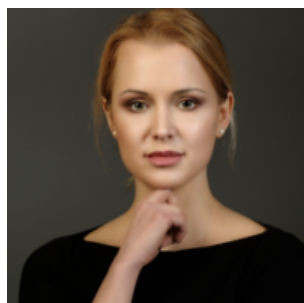
Entrepreneurial Woman Project is a series of workshops designed specifically for women who want to start a business and need guidance to start the process.
